




These are the things that we will be working on every time we get together.



Summary of Minutes

July 10, 2018



- * Page will be following up on dates with Luke and Lisa to continue with Strategic Planning
- * Cake for Volunteer Recognition was ordered, Melanie will be cutting and serving cake.
- * Shetek Conference restructuring: Roskamp and Friewald motioned that we stay in Zone 2 conference and not be moved to Zone 3 conference.
- * Kevin brought forward 3 motions to bring to the Mid-Year Meeting: Motion 1– Properties board recommends to repair canopy and soffits on East Entry and South Entry for the amount of \$18,120. Motion was passed. Motion 2– Properties board recommends to replace sanctuary and skylight court lights to LED bulbs for \$6,285. Motion was passed. Motion 3– Properties board recommends to install air conditioner units for 2nd floor cost of \$13,350, and 3rd floor at a cost of \$6,600. Motions were passed at Mid-year meeting.
- * Lisa Petersen spoke on a new collaborative program that Wartburg Seminary has developed. If agreed upon this would be a collaborative with Wartburg, the Synod and ALC. This will allow Lisa to "train" under Pastor Sarah and also be able to continue Youth and Family coordinator duties on a path toward ordained ministry. More details will be forwarded to ALC Leadership and Boards to allow the congregation to reflect on embarking on this process with Lisa.



At a special congregational meeting on July 15 the members of American Lutheran voted unanimously to extend a call to Pastor Adam Roberts to serve as pastor with Pastor Sarah Tade'.

Pastor Roberts comes to us with ten years of pastoral experience. This is his third call. He previously served calls in North Dakota and, most recently, in Wisconsin.


