

Please bring your own chairs and beverages and come and join us around the fire pit on the church lawn, weather permitting.





### CHURCH COUNCIL NOTES FROM June 2019 MEETING

- Mid-Year Meeting is scheduled for July 21.
- Ad-hoc Committee Members John Shamp and Keith Pohlman have volunteered to be the council members to the committee. Discussion on volunteers and naming the committee members. Rosalie Brodin and Amanda Wilson were selected.
- MSC (K. Pohlman/L. Jaakola ) to recommend by Mutual Ministry Committee and Budget and Finance, an increase in compensation for Gina Hauge, Administrative Assistant of \$1.05 per hour based on expanded duties (website coordinator) retroactive to May 27, 2019.
- MSC (L. Cartwright/K. Pohlman) to recommend to the congregation at the midyear meeting to use funds from the Renovation Fund not to exceed the \$80,000 that was borrowed last June, to purchase a new commercial water heater for the church for an estimated cost of \$7000.00.
- MSC (K. Pohlman/ S. Johnson) recommend raising the capital expenditure that must go to the congregation in the constitution from \$5000 to \$10,000.



### June 7-8, 2019 Redwood Falls

The stated goal of the Assembly was that participants leave with the body of Christ stronger and the leaders of our synod encouraged, ready to move forward living out our Christ centered "Everyday Spirituality." We were *thanked* for our mission support dollars which make our ministry at the synod level possible.

Some actions of the Assembly were:

- Election of a new Vice-President, Freeman Woodberry of Jackson, to replace Gwen Arneson (sister of Jane Cartwright) who has served in this capacity for two decades. A number of other positions were filled by election.
- Receive the Treasurer's and Bishop's reports. Approve the 2020 Budget and Compensation Guidelines.
