Pastors Message

March 2019



Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6th. I love this time of the year! Worship is so rich! A free standing cross gets set up, and our hearts are led to think on Jesus. Think about who he was - what he suffered - and how he is with us in our suffering. We think about the fact that he knows us, but still loves us, *enough to give his own life!!!*

It's easy to see that Lent is the holiest season of our church calendar as we prepare to mark Jesus' death and Resurrection. So I hope you will set aside these 40 days (not counting Sundays) to take notice, and take part.

I love Lent because we are together more. This is the time of yea where American Lutheran is joined every night by Bethany Lutheran of Bergen. No matter what worship service you attend at ALC, during Lent we're all here together on Wednesday night. We eat together at Lenten Suppers. Then we worship together. Following worship, there is opportunity to study together. That's a lot of together! I love that. It's so much about what being a Christian means. We are not alone. We're part of a community that shares a faith, hope, and a passion for serving, like Christ served. Above all, we share love!

How can we grow as a community this Lenten season? There is so many of us, and we can't know everyone, but *I would invite you to try something*: as you come to the Lenten Supper, instead of finding a spot by someone you know, sit by someone you don't and introduce yourself. Share conversation along with your meal. You may have found a new friend! Next to you is not a stranger but a brother or sister in the Body of Christ. We are God's people, together.

Our theme for Lent is **40 Days with Jesus**. Videos on our screens will show eyewitness accounts that dramatically retell the course of Christ's ministry leading up to his crucifixion. They highlight major events in Christ's life and how they impact people's lives today. These videos are produced by the "Skit Guys". If you don't know them, check them out. Or just come to Lenten Worship! I'm looking forward to it!



Forty Day Challenge! Church and Society is challenging **EVERYONE** to give \$1 a day for forty days during lent. The money collected will be given to the Southwest



Lutheran Social Services of Minnesota, Changing Lives!!

"The kind of person God made is the kind of person we serve." This was one of the comments made by Rev. Kathryn Tiede, Senior Director of Church Partnerships & Philanthropy who visited American Lutheran Church on February 10th to share the story of the work of Lutheran Social Services of Minnesota. She gave a Temple Talk during worship, and also spoke in an Adult Forum. We learned so much! One of the greatest needs is for **foster care** and **adoption**. 800 children are currently ready for adoption. Across the state, 9,400 children are in foster care on any given day, a figure that has risen dramatically in the last 5 years due to the opioid crisis. Parents are in jail or are dead. This is a reminder to everyone to get unused prescription meds out of our cabinets, and to the police station.

We learned about **REACH Mankato Drop in Center**, a safe and non-judgmental place for young people to come and receive assistance to get back on their feet. This would be a great place to take a tour! They have a Wish List for current needs. We were also informed of the problem of sex trafficking of children in Minnesota, and particularly in our region along the I-90 corridor. Safe Harbor is a program that addresses this problem.

One of the LSS activities where volunteers serve is through Camp Noah, a camp for children who have been through trauma/crisis. The program was created based on needs of kids coming out of floods. The camp happens 9 – 12 months after the trauma.

All who attended Rev. Tiede's Adult Forum were impressed by the scope of the work of LSS of MN. LSS is the service branch of the Lutheran Church, and has 2,500 employees. 10,000 people volunteer a year in various LSS sponsored services. Disaster Relief is currently in need of volunteers. 17,000 veterans a year receive services through LSS. Maybe you have a need that could be well served by LSS too.

Here in Windom, the Senior Dining program and Meals on Wheels out of the Community Center is a program of LSS, where over 10,000 meals were served in 2018! Kelly Kleven from ALC directs this program, and Melanie Shamp helps to prepare the good food! Nice work!

Lutheran Social Services joins Catholic Charities as being the two largest church based social service organizations in the country.

If you would like to volunteer with LSS, make a monetary contribution, or learn more, stop by the office and review the array of materials our visitor left for our information. What a privilege to partner with LSS! Pastor Sarah


