THIS WEEKEND MARKS JUNETEENTH (JUNE 19TH). Juneteenth commemorates the day when the last enslaved African Americans learned they were free. Confederate soldiers surrendered in April 1865, but word didn't reach the last enslaved black people until June 19th, when Union soldiers brought the news of freedom to Galveston, Texas. That was also about two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation freeing slaves in the Southern states. Juneteenth represents the ways in which freedom for black people has been delayed. It is a reminder that 'nobody is free until everybody's free". Let's use this newly formed national holiday as a day to reflect and to grow as a nation and as a people.


