Left Side: But God sets forth a light of peace, delivering flesh to bare bones, bringing workers for harmony and justice in places of discord and strife.

**Right Side:** (*light candle 1*) We light first, the candle of hope, trusting that hope for a savior remains.

Left Side: (light candle 2) And we light the second, believing that God's Son might usher in a new order, where the lion and lamb lie peacefully together.
