

Pastor's Message



"What is Lent for?" The question came up at the Worship and Music Board meeting as we began planning for Lent 2023. "It's a season to remember your baptism, be renewed in your faith, and lean into the story of Jesus' suffering and death" I said. We do that last part, concentrating on Jesus suffering and death, especially during Holy Week, and through many of the hymns that we sing during Lent. Sometimes we make personal sacrifices during Lent to draw us closer to God, and to help us remember the sacrifice Jesus made for us: giving his own life.

On Wednesday evenings during Lent, Bethany Lutheran and American Lutheran will worship together with the beautiful *Holden Evening Prayer*. Each night will include a reading from scripture and a reading from the book *Wholehearted Faith* by renowned author Rachel Held Evans. This was Rachel's last book before her untimely death at age 37. Rachel encourages us to be real, to ask questions, to be honest and vulnerable, so that we can be changed by the God who loves us so much he gave us Jesus. She invites us to recenter ourselves this season in the ancient words of the *Shema*:

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone.
You shall love the Lord your God
with all your heart,
and with all your soul,
and with all your might.
Deuteronomy 6.4-5

"Heart and soul and might: in other words, we are to love God with our whole selves, our whole messy and complicated and conflicted selves." Wholehearted Faith p. 56
I look forward to what we will learn, and how we will be reshaped as a people during these forty days!

A final word: when I make pastoral visits, I often find that one of you has been there first, caring for the person that I also came to care for. I am so grateful for the way that you are community together, loving and serving in the Body of Christ.

Jesus taught them in parables saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that someone took and sowed in his field; It is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the greatest of shrubs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches." Matthew 13.31-32

May our congregation and the community that we form inside and outside of the church provide a home, a place of shelter, and safety for the great variety of people who like the birds "make nests in its branches."





The forty days represent the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry. (Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter" as we look forward to the Resurrection.) Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. Lent is a time to focus on our relationship with God, as we think of Jesus suffering and death and the coming glory of his resurrection.


