

**BLESSING OF THE QUILTS AND BABY CARE KITS** will be on May 7th, 2023 at our 9:00 AM Worship Service. **GLOW SEWING DAYS TOTAL:** The American Lutheran quilters/GLOW members have completed 75 quilts, 117 School Kits, 166 Baby Care Kits, and 23 Personal Care Kits. 23 quilts will be donated to the Women of Today Christmas Cheer Box, and the last 50 quilts and all the other items will be donated to Lutheran World Relief. **THANK YOU** to everyone who donated items and their time to help make this happen! Each year, women of ALC meet twice a month from January through April to make quilts and care kits. Records kept over the last 32 years show that the ALC women (and a few men along the way) made 3, 320 quilts, 2,450 baby care kits, 1, 429 school kits, and 568 personal care kits. Over the years, some kits and quilts were donated locally to the hospital, Sharing Center, Christmas Cheer Box and Shetek quilt auction, but most were donated to Lutheran World Relief. **THANK YOU** to the congregation for your support through noisy offerings and donations of materials. Another way to support our Quilt and Kit ministry is to donate to the shipping fund.

LWR approximate cost to deliver quilts and kits overseas:

One quilt - \$2.25 One school kit - \$1.40

One personal care kit - \$2.65\* One baby care kit - \$1.30
