Pastor's Message

The Lord is not slow about his promise, as some think of slowness, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish, but all to come to repentance.

-2 Peter 3:9

I was chatting with a pastor not long ago who was telling me that he conceals and carries a gun at all times, even during worship. He tells me that there are quite a few pastors who are packing heat at all times, which, to be honest, tripped me up a bit.

Now, with the shooting of the nine people at a Bible study in Charleston back in 2015 you can bet your bottom dollar that as a pastor, as someone called to care for all who walk into this building as if they were my children, I most certainly have spent a lot of time wondering about what to do if a shooter were to come into our congregation, which was the topic of my conversation with this pastor.

He said to me how it is our responsibility to protect our people, to which I fully agree. The conversation from this point then got hard. It's hard to write about. And it isn't pretty. But that's the way the world is: it's hard, hard to write about, and not pretty.

I told him my struggle, which is if a gunman gets killed while shooting people then he has no chance to repent and very may well end up in hell for eternity. I said my struggle is that I never want to be responsible, in any way, even remotely, for anyone possibly ending up in hell.

Now naturally the pastor asked, "So then you just let your people get murdered?" And this is where it gets hard, and not pretty, and I ask you to read this in its entirety before you judge me.

I said I would do everything in my power to subdue a gunman. I will charge, tackle, throw things, wrestle, I will willingly take multiple bullets to protect the people entrusted to me because I know where I, and we, will end up. But I don't know where the gunman will end up.

I think of the passage above telling those who love God what God wants; almost like a good friend letting slip what they want for their birthday. I think that for those who want to give God the perfect gift, is there anything better than bringing God people who were lost? And vice-versa then, how awful is it when we lose an opportunity to save a soul?

I am not telling you what to do here. I can't imagine condemning anyone who kills a gunman to save lives. What I am trying to convey in this article is that, one, these are discussions that we *should* be having with one another. I appreciate the ability to talk with others about extremely divisive and touchy subjects in a calm way even when we don't come to an agreement.

Secondly, I am also trying to convey that we, as servants of Jesus, are called to bring as many souls to Christ as possible. Scripture teaches that God is especially concerned with lost souls and that the party in Heaven goes up a couple notches when the lost are found (Luke 15) compared to when "the found" arrive.

That's not saying that we throw our lives away needlessly and simply die. On the contrary, Jesus seems to be saying to me that we are to use everything we have, even our own lives if it's the last resort, to win souls for Christ.

Personally, I want to live to be at least a hundred, but even one hundred years is a drop in the bucket next to eternity. By all means, live this life up as much as you can, but also remember that this life is *really* short, and we have been gifted (yes, gifted) with work to do for God.

However you live, may your life be used to bring as many people to Jesus as possible no matter what the cost, knowing that that cost is making our eternal party in Heaven even better.

The Shetek Conference, which includes congregations in Jackson, Cottonwood, Nobles, Murray, Rock and Pipestone Counties (SW MN Synod of the ELCA) and the Ondini Partnership (SE Diocese of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in South Africa) have been partnering together since 2008 for the sake of the gospel. Individuals from our conference have made trips to South Africa in 2008, 2009, 2011, 2014 & 2017 to support our brothers and sisters in Christ in several areas. Members of American Lutheran Church, Michael Wojahn, Karen Skarpol, Amanda Skarpol, Pastor Sarah Tadé, Yanick and Isaac Tadé have been privileged to take part in those visits. We have also received guests from Ondini here in the Shetek Conference, most recently in 2013. Our partners have a deep and abiding faith, as they actively live out their Christian lives. In these past years, they have struggled with COVID, poverty, lack of rain, shortage & death of pastors, and leadership changes within their diocese and circuits.



We are excited to have one young man from the Ondini Circuit, Sicelo Masando, coming to work at Shetek Lutheran Ministries as a counselor this summer.

The Shetek Conference will host a potluck on July 22 @ 4 PM at Immanuel Lutheran in rural Fulda to honor Sicelo and our Ondini partners. Anyone interested in the partnership is welcome to attend! We are also in the process of inviting 4-5 members of the Ondini Partnership to the Shetek Conference in 2024.


