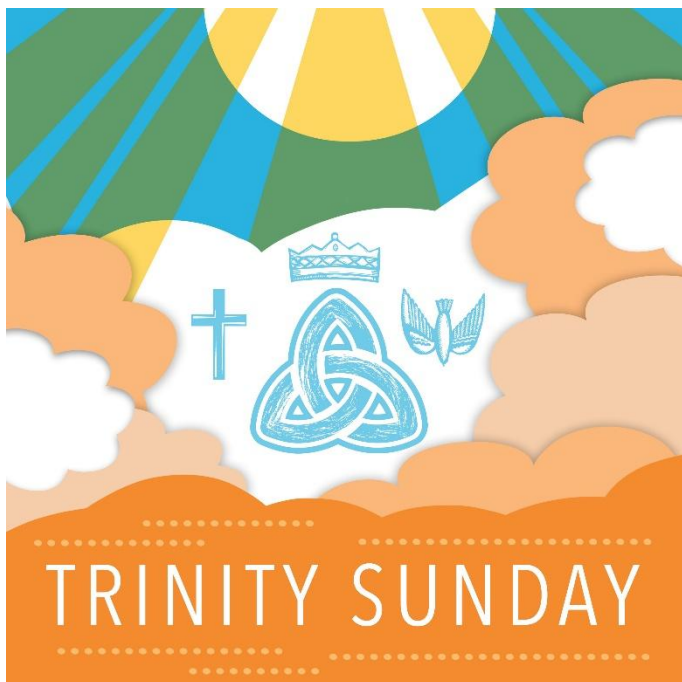

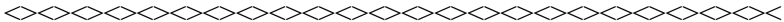
**POSTLUDE      ++++++**

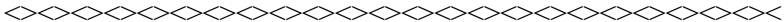
