Pastor's Message

A God Pause in the Interim

August often feels like a deep breath before the busyness of fall begins. The gardens are full, the days are long, and many of us squeeze in one last trip to the lake or a late-summer vacation. It's a season that invites us to pause....to rest, to pray, and to take stock.

In this season of interim ministry at American Lutheran Church, I want to encourage all of us to take what I call a "God Pause." It's something I used to teach when I served as a backpacking guide in the Colorado mountains: don't rush past the beauty. Pause. Take in the view. Notice what God is doing in the moment. And let that moment shape you.

This interim time is a kind of spiritual pause for our congregation. We are not standing still but we are invited to be thoughtful. Prayerful. In conversation with each other about where we've been. And hopeful about where we are going.

My father, who was ordained as a pastor back in 1958, used to say something to me that still rings true today:

"A congregation is a business. A congregation is a family. And if one or the other of those truths is forgotten — trouble will be the result."

Wise words.

There *is* a business side to congregational life. We're entering a season where important business-like tasks lie ahead: formalizing a new committee, finalizing and submitting paperwork, organizing for interviews. In many other settings, we'd call that a *hiring process*. But the church is different. We don't just hire a pastor, we *call* a pastor. And that word "call" reminds us that there's something deeper going on here: a spiritual process, grounded in prayer, discernment, and trust in the Holy Spirit.

Because at our core, we are not just an organization. We are a *family of faith*. And families don't simply fill a vacancy. They prepare their hearts to receive someone new into their shared life. In this case, a person who will immediately assume a central place in the midst of the family from the moment they are called to be the Lead Pastor.

So in this season of transition, I invite you to pause and reflect:

- How are we preparing our hearts to welcome this new person into the center of our faith family?
- What habits of grace, forgiveness, and hospitality can we strengthen now so that we're ready to receive and support the next chapter of this church's life together?

What might God be asking us to notice during this pause about ourselves, our mission, our hopes? And I invite you into conversation with each other about these things.

August is a good month to pause. Let's use this time well.

CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES FROM JULY 2025 MEETING

Devotions and opening prayer were provided by Pastor Steven.

No correspondence was shared.

The secretary's report for June was reviewed and approved, MM/S/C (Kevin, Nick).

The treasurer's report for June was reviewed and approved. MM/S/C (Nick, Kevin).

Pastor reports were reviewed.

Old Business

- 1. Update on call process Only 40 pastoral search surveys have been returned. Board members are encouraged to complete one. Pastor Steven and Heather Culuris from the Synod are reviewing the MSP draft and will be working on next steps. We are still looking for volunteers for the Call Committee.
- 2. Funeral fees Fees were accepted and our pastors are empowered to waive fees at their discretion. MM/S/C (Kim, Nick).
- 3. Holiday Fair will be Saturday, November 8, 2025. Penny Raia will do publicity. CIS and Spiritual Life are managing the brunch and lunch. Jackie Turner and Kay Evers will coordinate the bake sale. Karen Skarphol will lead lefse making. Beth Scrivens will be asked about craft sales. Youth will do new and nearly new sales. The youth will retain their funds raised. The rest of the profit will be split: 25% Shetek Lutheran Bible Camp, 25% minvan fund, 10% Shetek Ondini Circuit, 10% Lutheran Disaster Relief, 10% Sharing Center, 10% ALC Buliding/Maintenance, 10% Lutheran Refugee Service. MM/S/C (Nick, Kevin).

New Business

- 1. Mid-year meeting will be July 20, 2025. Agenda items will include the state of the church, an update on the call process and notes from the annual meeting in January.
- 2. Mutual Ministry will discuss increasing hours for the Part-Time Custodian.

Board Reports:

Worship & Music – Discussed the cost to use Tegels Park for Worship. Nick will contact Tim Hogan at the City about the fee and liability. Purchased ELW Guitar Accompaniment Edition of Service Music & Hymns.

Spiritual Life & Fellowship - Rootbeer floats will be served after Worship at Tegel's Park on August 10th.

<u>Discipleship/Marketing & Stewardship</u> – Will be doing a Temple Talk on estate planning event in November. Working on a brochure to hand out at the Windom Area Health's Health Fair booth on July 23rd.

Budget & Finance - Paid bills on hold.

<u>Properties</u> – Bell tower sealing will be done next week. Working with Kato Roofing on patching roof. Holtz Cleaning will clean the carpets before VBS.

<u>Christian Education</u> – Preparing for VBS. Offering will be split ½ to World Hunger and ½ to Sharing Center. 2025-2026 Wednesday School and Sunday School theme is "God Rocks!" Rally Day is September 7th.

Church in Society - Served at The Banquet on Monday, July 7th. Block Party is August 17th.

Youth & Family – Reviewed graduation activities and the Duluth Mission Trip. Summer Youth Group is getting off the ground with leadership from Lilly Derickson. Summer Breakfast Club is monthly. Boundary Waters Trip is July 13-18. Youth are going to Arnold's Park on August 17th and will be back in time for the Block Party.

GLOW - Three members went on a bus trip on June 16th to Lutheran World Relief and Global Health Ministries. Bible Study on July 16th at 2 pm.


