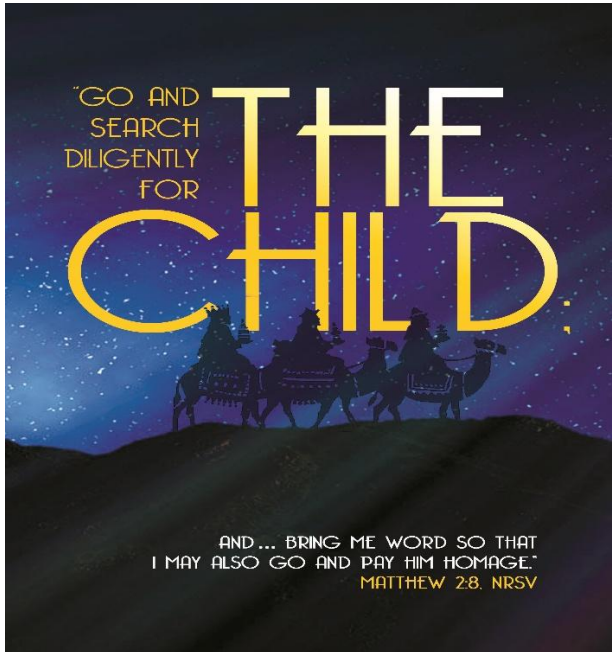

As many of you are eligible to take your annual RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) from your retirement savings, please consider a tax free gift to the church. Why Consider This Gift? • Your gift will be put to use today, allowing you to see the difference your donation is making. • If you are required to take minimum distributions, you can use your gift to satisfy all or part of your obligation. • You pay no income taxes on the gift. The transfer generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your deductions. • Since the gift doesn't count as income, it can reduce your annual income level. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax. **Ask your financial adviser** about this RMD option. The general deadline for taking your 2025 Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) is December 31, 2025. Thank you for your consideration.
